The Saskatchewan Health Authority's Medical First Responders (MFR's) are **locally trained volunteers** who respond to emergency calls. The MFR's are dedicated, reliable and trusted leaders/mentors who have accepted the responsibility of caring for neighbors and community members while waiting for the ambulance to arrive.



Edam Medical First Responders are trained and licenced volunteers that provide 24 hour per day/7day a week on call service to our community. Edam Medical First Responders group was started in 1996. Over these years we have served the Edam Area on numerous medical incidents. Through donations from our local citizens we have been able to purchase our own First Responder Vehicles and the equipment to perform our duties. The Saskatchewan Health Authority does not fund our group.

## Our Goal

To raise money for a newer First Responder vehicle that will serve our needs to serve your needs. Our present First Responder Vehicle recently was taken out of service due to engine failure. The cost to replace engine and labour isn't feasible due to high kms on our unit.
